THE FARM:

- Tonnemaker Family Orchards is a fourth-generation family farm located about 3 ½ hours east of Seattle in Royal City, WA. Royal City is about 19 miles south-west of Moses Lake in central Washington.

OVERVIEW:

- We have two options for our subscription program in 2011—either the “10lb Club” or a more traditional Weekly Subscription Program which works similarly to other farm’s CSA programs, except you pay for a weekly box rather than a share of the farm.
- Both options are designed to be a companion to vegetable CSA’s or vegetable subscription programs.
- Both subscription options come with a weekly newsletter and recipe ideas (full recipes are available on our blog).

	Weekly Box Program	10lb Club
Overview:	<p>This program runs for 20 weeks with deliveries to a neighborhood drop site each week. We have three size options to choose from: Mini, Half, and Full.</p> <p>The Mini Box is suited for a single person and contains 4-5 pounds or types of fruit on average.</p> <p>The Half Box is suited for a couple, or two people, and contains 8-9 pounds or types of fruit on average.</p> <p>The Full Box is suited for a family of 3-4 and contains 12-13 pounds or types of fruit on average.</p>	<p>The week’s box offers what is at the peak season for that week in either 10 pound or 5 pound quantities. The varieties of produce may be available earlier in the season, but this is when they are at their best. You can subscribe for the entire season, for only specific box, or multiple boxes on any given week. This program is ideal for those folks who like to stock up on fruit while it’s in season or for those who do canning.</p>
Schedule:	<p>The first box will be delivered to the drop sites as soon as we have cherries available. We’re thinking that should be around June 28<sup>th</sup>, but we will send an email in mid-June to confirm.</p> <p>The program runs 20 weeks from start to finish (if we are not able to harvest cherries in June, then the season will extend one week further into November) with the last box delivered the week of November 8<sup>th</sup>.</p>	<p>The first box will be delivered to a drop-site between July 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 16<sup>th</sup>. The next boxes are weekly or every-other week (to allow for consumption) after that. The last box will be available October 20<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>. We will send you a specific schedule once the season starts (as it’s a little weather-dependent) with dates and what you signed up for.</p>

If you decide to purchase the entire offering, the cost is \$414.50.</p> <p>Registration is due by June 15<sup>th</sup>.</p>
<p>Payment Options:  Personal Checks  Debit  Credit</p>	<p>Pay in full at registration -or- 4 payments– first due with registration; second due the 1<sup>st</sup> of each subsequent month beginning in July. If payment is not received by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, your produce will not be delivered.</p>	<p>Full payment is due at registration.</p>

<p>Forgotten Boxes/bags:</p>	<p>If you forget to pick up your box/bag during the drop off hours, it will be donated to a local food bank. If you know in advance that you will be gone, we can either double your box the next week or make other arrangements.</p>	
<p>Cancellation Policy:</p>	<p>You may cancel at any time and we will refund the unused portion of your weekly subscription, however cancellations are subject to a cancellation fee of \$25.00.</p>	<p>Please notify us at least two days prior to your next drop date if you wish to change or cancel your order. We will refund the unused portion of your subscription.</p>
